

Make-A-Wish/MAA Exhibit      May 6-7<sup>th</sup> 10 am-4-pm

Entry Fee: \$35 per participating artist. This fee will go to the Make-A-Wish Foundation.

1. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. MAA must **receive the entry fee and form on or before** April 25, 2006 from artists who intend to participate in this event. No late entries will be accepted.
2. Only Gallery members or previous gallery members may show at this exhibit.
3. Two artists will share each 10x10 booth space with 5 panels/racks per space. Artists are responsible for bringing their own display racks and for arranging with their booth partner which of them will bring the racks.
3. Ten spaces are available in side and 8 spaces (4 booths) are available outdoors. Tents for artists outdoors in front will also have 2 artists per booth. Tents must be dismantled overnight and paintings may be stored in the gallery or brought home and re-hung the following day. (Set up by 9 am)
4. Original artworks (flat works only), no nudes. Cards and prints may be sold at the show. Subjects/formats/compositions should be original by artist - no works generated from pre-published sources.
5. All booth set-ups must be complete by 9 am. It is suggested that we meet at the gallery by 7:30 am to accomplish this in time.
6. All sales must be transacted through the sales desk, including artwork, prints, cards, etc. A 20% commission will be taken - 10% will go to the Make-A-Wish Foundation of NH and 10% of all sales will go to the Gallery. An additional 3.6% will be subtracted from your sale for MasterCard/Visa transactions. Artists should keep a written record of their sales for personal use showing type of sale and percentages taken.
7. Artists are encouraged to donate artwork, prints, cards, etc as door prizes. All proceeds from donated raffle items will go to the Make-A-Wish Foundation of NH.
8. Artists will all be given raffle tickets and will be expected to try to sell them at their booths. Keep money safe for turn in at the end of each day. Be sure to have the customer fill out all info on the ticket. Raffles and door prizes will be announced at 3 PM on Sunday.
9. Participating artists are expected to work their booths for the entire show. If you can't be there, you will need to get someone to stay for you and help clean up afterward **or you should not exhibit.**
10. Each exhibiting artist is responsible for bringing a finger food for the refreshment table **each day.** You will be asked to sign up on the list of possible goodies prior to the show. Simple snacks: cheese and crackers, chips, pretzels, cookies, veggies and dip, fruit tray, cola or other soft drinks, etc.
